Facts and Figures on the Estate Tax

- Only the wealthiest 2% of Americans are subject to the estate tax.
- One half of all estate taxes are paid by the 0.15% wealthiest Americans. These are people with estates larger than \$5 million.
- By providing an unlimited deduction for charitable giving, the estate tax offers a valuable incentive to donate to charity and has played a crucial role in creating a thriving nonprofit sector.
- In Minnesota, repeal of the estate tax would equal a loss of \$197 million per year in charitable giving, or an average of \$33,708 per Minnesota charity.

Complete repeal of the estate tax would be bad for our democracy, our economy, and our society. As a constructive part of the U.S. tax structure for 85 years, the estate tax does not prevent families from passing on wealth to their heirs, and encourages charitable giving.
